

Healthcare Services for Pregnant Women

You may qualify for free services to help you get the healthcare you need.



What help is available?

If you are pregnant and have MO HealthNet (Missouri Medicaid), you may qualify for additional services at **no cost**, including:

- Medical services (including preventive care)
- Prenatal care (including ultrasounds, delivery)
- Postnatal care for 12 months after the end of pregnancy
- Pharmacy benefit (prescription medicine)
- Transportation to medical appointments
- Behavioral health services
- Family planning
- STD testing and treatment
- Care management
- Dental services
- Vision services
- Hearing aids and testing
- Diabetes treatment & self-management
- Podiatry (foot care) services
- Physical therapy
