Healthcare Services for Pregnant Women



What is covered?

Missouri Medicaid, also known as MO HealthNet, provides healthcare services to eligible pregnant women, which includes:

- Medical & preventative services
- Healthcare during pregnancy and 12 months after the date of delivery
- Transportation to medical appointments
- Behavioral health services
- Family planning
- STD testing and treatment
- Pharmacy benefit (prescription medicine)
- Care management
- Dental services
- Vision services
- Hearing aids and testing
- Diabetes treatment & self-management
- Podiatry (foot care) services
- Physical therapy





Am I eligible?

To be eligible for MO HealthNet for Pregnant Women, you must be pregnant and:

- Live in Missouri and be a United States Citizen (or qualified non-citizen)
- Have (or apply for) a Social Security Number
- Make less than the annual income limit for your household size
